

SOS 492/493 Honors Directed Study/Thesis Credit Application

Honors Thesis Credit

Any student working with School of Sustainability faculty may register for SOS 492 and 493. Sustainability students working with a faculty member outside of the School of Sustainability should register under the departmental prefix of their faculty director.

Students may enroll in 3 credits of SOS 492 Honors Directed Study and 3 credits of SOS 493 Honors Thesis (6 credits total). SOS 493 and qualifying HON 493 projects may be used to satisfy the SOS 498 Capstone Workshop requirement for Sustainability majors.

Registration

To register for SOS 492 or SOS 493: Complete this form, including faculty signature, and submit to: sosadvising@asu.edu. In lieu of a physical signature, you may submit an email from your faculty member in which they acknowledge agreement to supervise your honors project and approve your enrollment in either SOS 492 or SOS 493 under their name.

Scheduling a Thesis/Creative Project Defense

The School of Sustainability assists its honors students in room reservations and promotion of their thesis presentation to the ASU community.

Students registered in SOS 493 may reserve a conference room in Wrigley Hall for their thesis presentations.

- The defense date and time must be confirmed with all faculty on the committee and with Barrett, The Honors College prior to reservation.
- Room reservations should be made at least two weeks prior to the defense, preferably earlier. Rooms in Wrigley Hall are not guaranteed to be available at the date/time requested.
